## Minor in Information Systems Graduation Requirements Checklist – Fall 2018

The minor in Information Systems is open to all students not majoring in either Computer Science or Information Systems or minoring in Computer Science. To declare the minor in Information Systems, students must complete ISE 108 or CSE101 with a grade of C or higher and possess a cumulative grade point average of 2.80 or higher. The minor requires seven courses totaling at least 21 credits as outlined below:
