

AI Students Talks Principles and Schedule

1. The first principle is that each student has **10 minutes** for a presentation. It means that team of 2 students has 20 minutes and team of 3 students has 30 minutes. You divide the time within your team accordingly to your needs! it can be 10 and 10 (for 2 people team) but it also can be 8 and 12, etc.. but not 3 and 17!

REMEMBER: it is VERY difficult to give a coherent, good, and informative short talk! It needs a lot of thinking and preparation. When your talk is ready TIME your talk, rehearse it. I will, as it happens at conferences all the time, interrupt the talk if it is too long.

2. Each team talk has to have two components: theory and application. Theory means a research paper or papers (it can be research ABOUT the application, of course), application means a real life application or a prototype of the application. BOTH parts MUST be somehow connected; it means you can have a paper on one subject and application on totally different subject.

3. Students are responsible for bringing the data projector and laptop from JAVITS, setting it BEFORE the class, and delivering it back to JAVITS. I will come at 2:20 and by this time all has to be ready for the first speaker. I will leave there list of students (in teams) and sign permission, so you just need to show them your ID.
