

**The semester is coming to a quick close and we need to get documentation and prototypes from your applications assembled for Anita to take to Senegal on the 29th.**

**Each group should submit the following things:**

- A written project summary which discusses the motivation, project design, development challenges, software platforms, etc. Basically a document that summarizes everything that you encountered and done and why during the semester. These will be starting drafts for the abstracts for the conference in Washington DC.

- A set of slides 5-10 that present the project to others. These should not be development slides, but summary slides. It should contain information on who you developed the application for, what is the developed application, technical summary of platform and software used, a map of the application (screen changes to screen), and future work/changes.

- Have a showable prototype of your program. It should be in some example working order. Do your best to incorporate the changes we most recently discussed. We want to depoly the current verisons on a phone for Anita to take with her on the 29th. So everyone PLEASE try to have somethign working, even if it doens't have all the screens or all the functionality. Use sample values and pictures to give people an idea of how the programs work.

Remember, the seminar will continue in the Spring and even if you aren't involve someone else will pick up where you left off. Please make sure to document everything and to forward all you code and information on to your teammates or Anita and I.
