

# Hand-In Instructions for CSE327 Project 1

Your course account home directory is H:\cse327\cse327\_#, where # is a number from 1 to 30. The “hand-in directory” for your projects is H:\cse327\cse327\_ta\cse327\_#, where # is the same number as above.

To hand in your assignment:

1. Go to your hand-in directory, and create a new folder there called “Project1”.
2. **Copy** all of the files and directories from your own directory that are related to this assignment into the new “Project1” directory you have created. This includes all of your Visual C++ files including source code and support files, as well as all of the files generated by your programs and by you. You should maintain the same directory structure as exists in your own directory.
3. Open your Visual C++ workspace in the new location, and recompile all of your programs, to be certain that they will compile properly in this location.
4. Using Notepad, Microsoft Word, or some other text editor, write a short file called “ReadMe.txt” or “ReadMe.doc”. This file should list the files you have written, and contain a brief description what each of those files is. (You do not have to list or provide descriptions of Visual C++’s temporary and support files, however.) This file should also explain how to use your programs. Place this file in the same directory where you have copied all of the other files to.
